Membership and attendance figures from 31 August 2013 (or earlier if they did not return in 2013) are given for these churches and they are shown highlighted in the spreadsheet.

Some other churches submitted incomplete returns. Attendance figures were again taken from previous years, and are given in italics. One church objected to providing numbers. Their previous data is included in the association and national totals, but is not shown against their record.

It is undoubtedly true that simply counting people is a highly limited measure for assessing church and missional health. This is one reason why multiple measures are requested and recorded, and available to be compared from one year to the next. Initiatives like the Church Life Survey provide another form of measure that can help churches as they seek to resource their congregations and be involved in God's mission in the world. If you have any ideas or comments on how we can best be recording and reporting data on our Baptist Churches in Aotearoa New Zealand, I would be delighted to hear from you.

## Baptisms

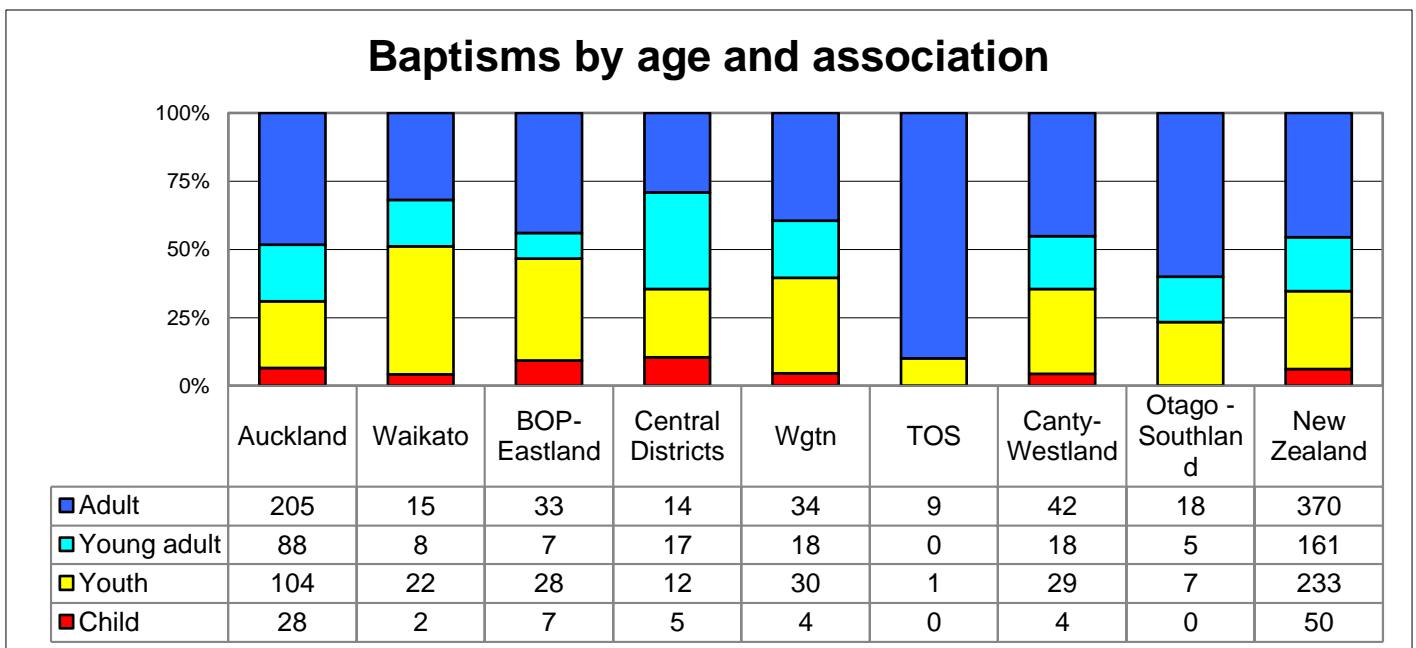
In the 2013-2014 year, the Baptist denomination performed its lowest number of baptisms since 1996, with just 854<sup>1</sup> baptisms celebrated.

While Canterbury/Westland recorded the same number of baptisms as last year, the other Associations all declined. Overall there was an 18% decline in the number of baptisms celebrated.

Who are we baptising?

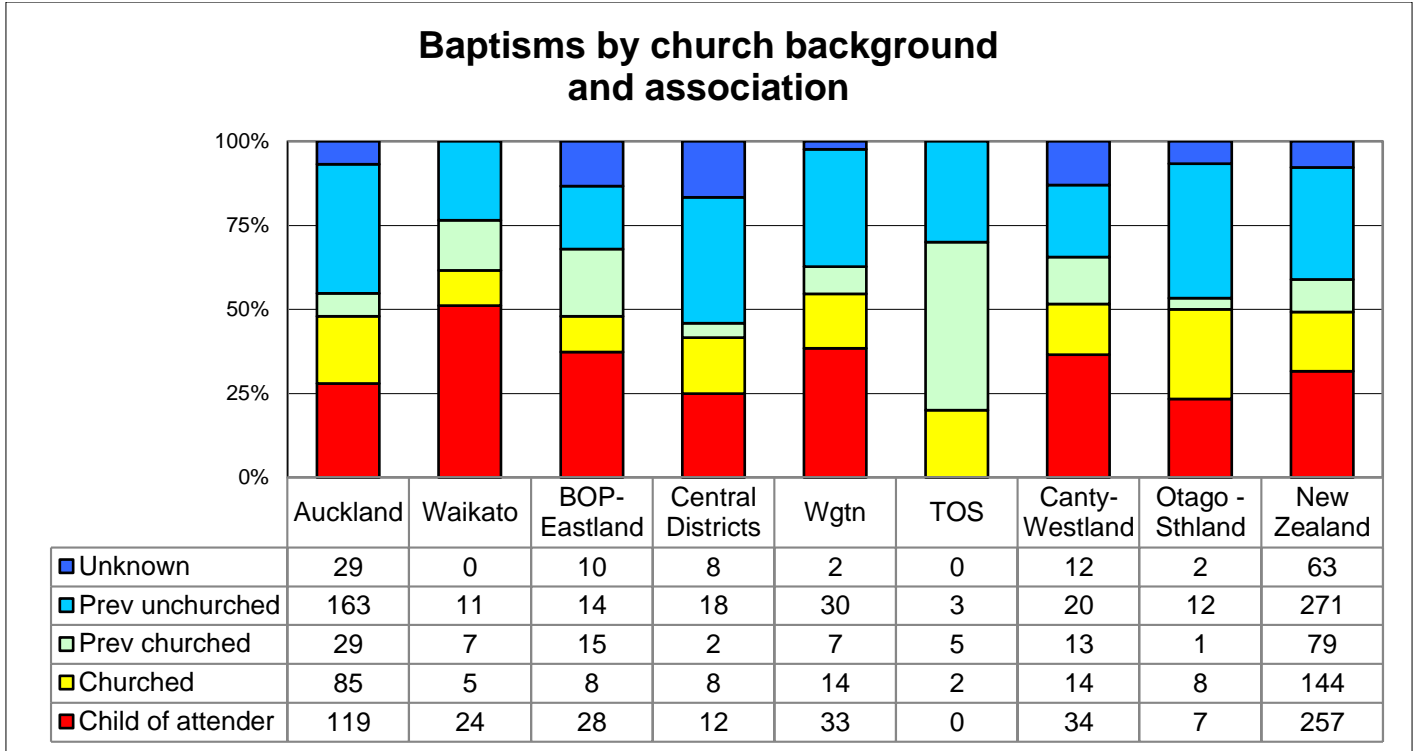
In terms of age: 6% were children aged 12 years and under.  
 29% of our baptisms are of people aged 13 to 18 years.  
 20% are aged between 19 and 25 years  
 45% are aged over 25 years, (as shown on the following graph)



<sup>1</sup> This includes the “approximately 40” people who were baptised at Windsor Park, but their data is not included in the following detailed analysis.

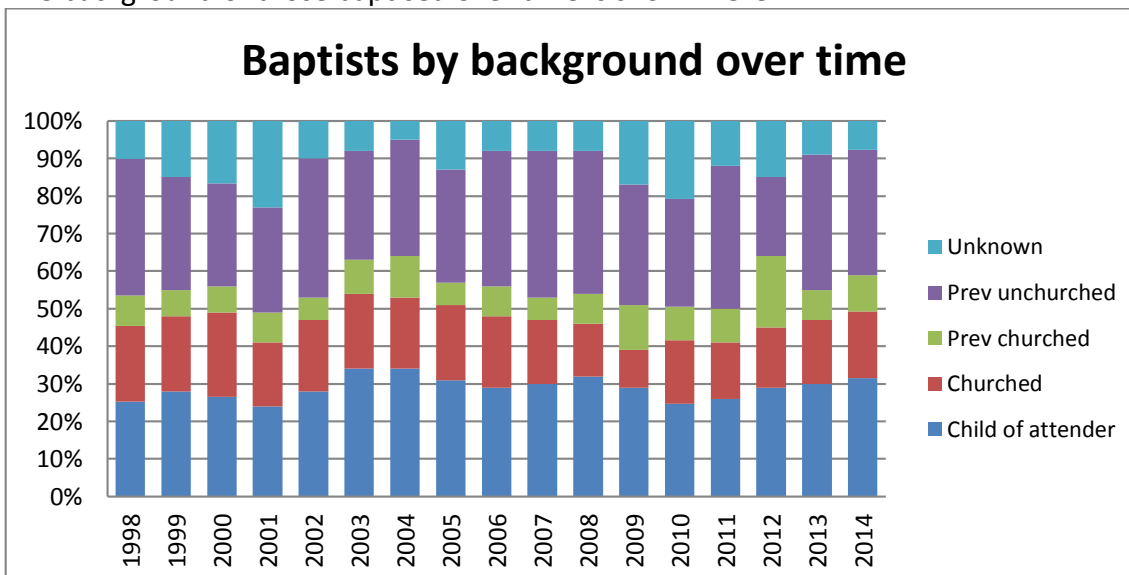
In terms of church background,  
 32% of the people baptised were the children (offspring) of people in the church.  
 18% were churched (attended another church before going to the one they were baptised in)  
 10% were previously churched (but hadn't regularly attended a church for at least 12 months prior to joining the church they were baptised in)  
 33% were previously unchurched  
 8% were of unknown background

Proportions by Association are shown in the following graph.

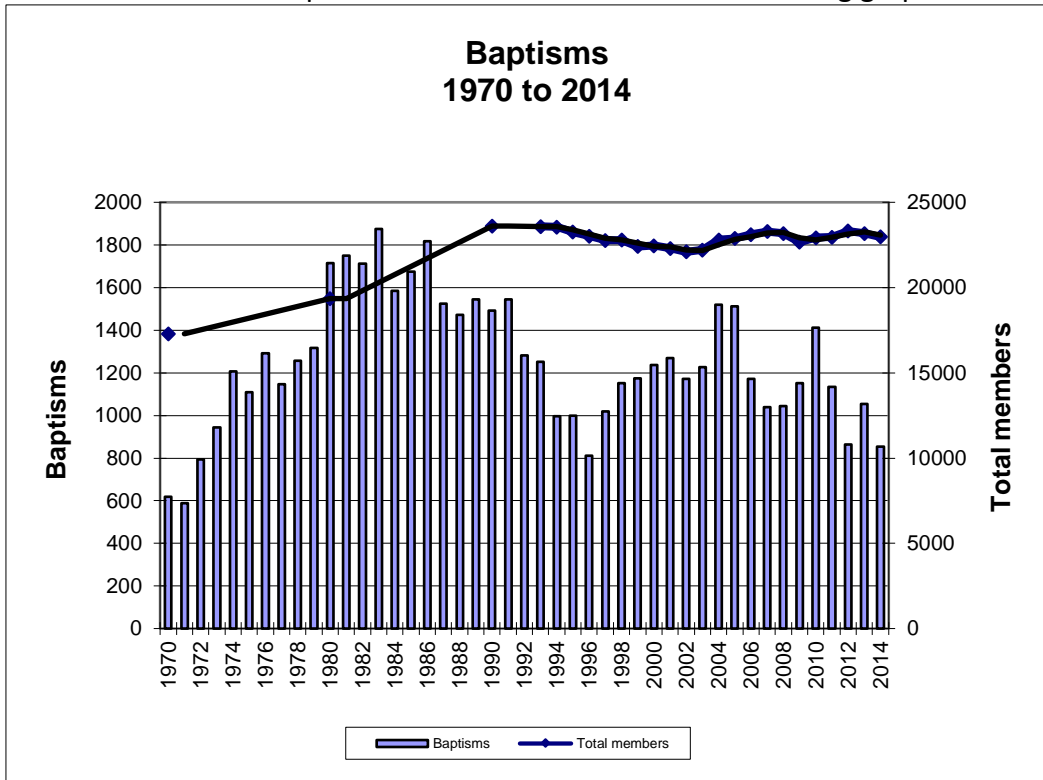


Baptisms throughout time

### Membership

Our 217 constituted churches have total resident memberships ranging from 5 to 1391 and resident memberships ranging from 5 to 1377. Overall we have a total membership of 22985 (just slightly lower than 2013's 23074) and a resident membership of 21961 (compared with 2013's 21937).

**Attendance**

We have 241 churches and fellowships with average weekly attendances ranging from 7 to 1356. There is a total weekly attendance of 36067, made up of 25941 adults (down 1243, or -4.6% on the 2013 figure), 3670 teenagers (down 339 or -8.4%) and 6456 children (down 276: -4.1%). Overall there was a decrease of 4.9%, representing 1858 individuals.

This is the eighth year in a row that the average weekly attendance of New Zealand Baptist churches has declined, and represents the largest decrease ever recorded. It also places Baptist average weekly church attendance at the lowest levels since attendances started being recorded in 1987. Of course it needs to be noted that part of this apparent decline is due to “overcounting” in early records, with attenders being considerably less likely to attend more than one service in 2014 than they were in the late 1980s and 1990s. The following table shows the growth rates of our Baptist churches between 2013 and 2014. 39.4% of Baptist churches decreased in attendance by more than 5% in the 2013-2014 period, while 22.8% increased by more than 5%. This contrasts with 31.8% and 27.6% respectively last year.

Eight churches recorded a decrease in attendance of 100 people or more. Just one church recorded an increase of more than 100 people.

In the past five years, 19 churches have decreased by more than 100 attenders, with a total decrease from those churches of 3329 people. In that same time period, five churches grew by more than 100, with the total increase from those nine churches being 708.

In the ten years to 2013, 31 churches declined by more than 100 attenders, with a total decrease from those churches of 6166 people. In that same period, 13 churches grew by more than 100, and those churches showed a total increase of 2587.

Thirty-two percent of our Baptist churches declined in all three time periods (2004-2014, 2009-2014 and 2013-2014).

***Frequency of attendance (adult attendance cf twa)***

While the average weekly adult attendance has decreased by 12.5% over the past ten years, the total worshipping adults (estimated number of adults that churches would expect to see at least once a month) has decreased by a lesser 4.9%. This continues to suggest that a greater proportion of people are attending less frequently than in the past.
